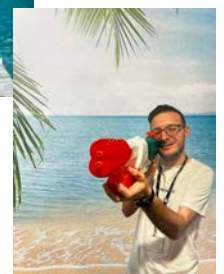
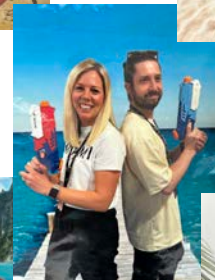
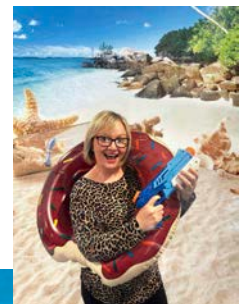
There will also be a scavenger hunt for children to complete on the day, with images of some of the grown ups they work with holding clues (there are a few examples to the right!)
