
## Where is it?

- Maes-y-Nant, Cross Lanes, Wrexham.
- Maes-y-Nant activity centre is our newest centre and is set in the beautiful Welsh countryside just outside of Wrexham. Maes-y-Nant dates back to the late Victorian era when it was built as a private house in around 1870. Its name Maes-y-Nant when translated means 'house by a stream'. In 1959 the house was sold and converted to a hotel with many of its original features being preserved to this day.



### Wet clothes

Robinwood have a drying room and provide laundry facilities. Clothing is washed on a 30 degree cycle and tumble dried. Please don't bring anything new or expensive, or that cannot be tumble dried. (They may not always be able to do laundry from water activities on the last day – in this case a bag will be provided for wet clothes). Due to the nature of our activities it is possible that clothes may occasionally get damaged. Clothing should be suitable for an outdoor environment. Old clothes are best. Walking boots are great, but a sturdy pair of trainers will be fine in dry weather. (You definitely don't need to buy walking boots especially for your trip.) Jeans are not ideal for the activities as they become very heavy when wet. Tracksuit or jogging bottoms are best. Please ensure your clothing is labelled with your name and if possible your school name. (It really helps us return lost property
